FRANKLIN, LOUISIANA

The St. Mary Parish Council met on this date in Regular Session with Chairman Kevin Voisin presiding and the following members present: Rev. Craig Mathews, Dale Rogers, Glen Hidalgo, Ken Singleton, Patrick Hebert, James Bennett, Sterling Fryou, Paul P. Naquin, Jr., and Gabriel Beadle. Absent was J Ina.

The Invocation was pronounced by Mr. Hidalgo and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Rogers.

Mr. Naquin moved that the reading of the minutes of the First Regular Meeting, July 11, 2018, be dispensed with and that the same be approved. Mr. Beadle seconded the motion, which carried.

Ellen Daigle Doskey, 7 Clairmont Lane, Houma, Louisiana appeared before the Council to announce her candidacy for First Circuit Court of Appeal Judge.

Parish President, David Hanagriff, informed that the Council of Governments meeting will be held on July 30, 2018 at 6:30 at the Atchafalaya Golf Course at Idlewild Clubhouse in Patterson, Louisiana.

Mr. Hanagriff reported that the AARP Senior Dinner will be held on August 6, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. at the AARP Building in Morgan City, Louisiana.

Mr. Hanagriff also reported that the Police Jury Association Region 3 meeting will be held on August 16, 2018 in Napoleonville, Louisiana.

Mr. Hanagriff stated that St. Mary Parish is hosting the 64<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference for the Organization of Parish Administrative Officials July 25-27, 2018 at Cypress Bayou Casino in Charenton, Louisiana.

In reference to Rev. Mathews' inquiry, Mr. Hanagriff stated that the oil leak along the railroad track from Centerville to Albania Plantation has been resolved.

Chief Administrative Officer, Henry "Bo" LaGrange, presented his report for a two (2) week period ending July 25, 2018.

Item 2 in Mr. LaGrange's report stated, "The Federal Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 (Supplemental) included funding to the Corps of Engineers totaling an allocation of \$1.6 billion of which \$15 million was provided for the Amite River and Tributaries Study-\$3 million, Upper Barataria Basin Study - \$3 million, Lake Pontchartrain Levee Lift - \$3 million, South Central Coastal Study - \$3 million, West Bank and Vicinity Levee Lift - \$3 million. They also received construction funds for Comite - \$343 million, Westshore Lake Pontchartrain - \$760 million, East Baton Rouge Flood Control Project - \$255 million, and Grand Isle - \$15 million."

Item 3 in Mr. LaGrange's report stated, "The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mississippi River Commission has written to advise that it will hold a public meeting aboard the MV Mississippi in Morgan City at the Port Commission Dock at 9:00 a.m. on August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018."

Rev. Mathews stated that he received an email from the Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) and Gilchrist Construction Company, LLC regarding contribution of four homes that they acquired during construction of the U.S. 90 & LA 318 Interchange to St. Mary Parish for the use of donations to four (4) St. Mary Parish families.

Rev. Mathews explained that St. Mary Community Action Committee Association, Inc. is assisting with funding sources to help with cost of moving those homes to the family's property.

Rev. Mathews expounded on the act of donation process and time frame to move these houses off of the state right-of-way.

Legal Counsel, Eric Duplantis expounded on Section 14 of the Constitution and stated that due to legal issues, it would be improper to expand the agenda to make a decision tonight.

Mr. LaGrange explained that further research needs to be done.

In regards to Rev. Mathews' suggestion, Mr. LaGrange stated that faster progress will be made if the Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) and Gilchrist Construction Company, LLC donates the houses directly to St. Mary Community Action Committee Association, Inc.

Mr. Voisin thanked Mr. LaGrange for speaking with Sheriff Scott Anslum for providing a deputy to be present at the meeting.

In reference to Mr. Beadle's inquiry, Mr. LaGrange stated that in the past, the Town of Berwick and City of Morgan City has contacted DOTD to remove debris on the U. S. 90 bridge in Morgan City.
