The St. Mary Parish Council met on this date in Regular Session with Paul P. Naquin, Jr., Chairman presiding and the following members present: Rev. Craig Mathews, J Ina, Dale Rogers, Glen Hidalgo, Gabriel Beadle, James Bennett, Sterling Fryou and Kevin Voisin. Absent were Ken Singleton and Pam Washington.

The Invocation was pronounced by Mr. Bennett and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Fryou.

Mr. Voisin moved that the reading of the minutes of the Second Regular Meeting, February 22, 2017, be dispensed with and that the same be approved. Mr. Fryou seconded the motion, which carried.

Ms. Cecelia “Beanie” Bonin, Public Defender – 16<sup>th</sup> JDC appeared before the Council to introduce herself and ask for moral and political support.

Ms. Bonin is requesting St. Mary Parish to adopt a resolution of support to be sent to Louisiana Legislators and Senators relative to the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Public Defender’s Office receiving adequate and stable state funding.

Mrs. Morgan, Clerk, stated that due to a conflict, Ms. Holly LeBlanc, Advocate Supervisor, CASA of the 16<sup>th</sup> JDC will appear before the Council at March 22, 2017 meeting.

Mrs. Beverly Domengeaux, St. Mary Parish Council on Aging, appeared before the Council to inform the Council that the Intergenerational Meeting will take place on March 9, 2017 at 6:00 at Berwick Civic Center, Berwick, LA.

Mrs. Tammy Rogers, Chez Hope, appeared before the Council to remind the Council that Chez Hope’s 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Trivia Night is scheduled for April 1, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. at the Patterson Civic Center, Patterson, LA.

Rev. Mathews requested to move and take action on Item 16A:

Carolyn Bowser, FBLA Advisor has written FBLA has been dedicated to inspiring and developing the next generation of leaders by preparing members for careers in business and business-related fields.

I am writing on behalf of the Future Business Leaders of America Chapter at Franklin Senior High School. We are asking for your support in helping the FBLA Students attend the State Leadership Conference at the Lafayette Convention Center/Cajundome on March 26-28, 2017.

With a humble appeal, we are asking for a monetary donation of \$500.00. Your monetary contribution would help defray travel and lodging expenses and would be greatly appreciated.

Ms. Carolyn Bowser, Franklin High School’s Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) Advisor appeared before the Council to ask for financial support in helping FBLA students attend the State Leadership Conference at the Lafayette Convention Center/Cajundome on March 26-28, 2017. Ms. Bowser stated that their budget is \$1,700.00 for two (2) nights.

Mr. Hanagriff reported that he met with John Chautin, field representative for Congressman Clay Higgins and that he also met with Lauren Casanova, Southwest Regional Director for Senator Bill Cassidy.

Mr. Hanagriff stated that a Proclamation was signed on behalf of Keep St. Mary Parish Beautiful and that an event will be held on Friday, March 10, 2017 at 8:30 a.m., Berwick Town Hall. Mr. Hanagriff also informed of the Special Olympics Event to be held on Friday, March 10, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in Morgan City.

Henry "Bo LaGrange, Chief Administrative Officer presented his report for a two (2) week period ending March 8, 2017. (All items in Mr. LaGrange's report are informational.)

Mr. LaGrange commented on Item 2 which stated "St. Mary Parish currently has 16 adjudicated properties available for sale at our contractor's web site, CivicSource.com. The next online auction of St. Mary Parish adjudicated properties will be held on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017. When an investor chooses to initiate the auction process on one or more properties, he or she will place a deposit of \$850.00 on each property, which starts the prerequisite legal research and notification process that is required before the auction takes place. The pre-sale process takes approximately 120 days to complete. If the current property owner pays all delinquent taxes and fees during the pre-sale period, the depositor is refunded the deposit and the sale is halted."
